## 2012 STALLION NOMINATIONS

### For the 2016 CANADIAN BREEDERS CHAMPIONSHIP CLOSE JANUARY 15, 2012

On January 15, 2012 nominations will close for stallions who will stand for service during the 2012 breeding season.

**NOMINATION OF THE STALLION ON JANUARY 15, 2012 accompanied by a payment of one fee equal to "one-half" of the stallion's 2012 advertised stud fee (minimum of \$500) WILL MAKE HIS ENTIRE CROP OF 2013 FOALS ELIGIBLE FOR NOMINATION (ON MAY 15, 2014) TO THE 2016 THREE-YEAR-OLD CANADIAN BREEDERS CHAMPIONSHIP.**

The minimum fee is \$500. Where a stallion has a different fee for colts and fillies, the colt fee shall apply.

A stallion 'not' nominated by the required January 15, 2012 closing date for stallion nominations will be accepted provided the nomination fee equal to "one-half" of the stallion's 2012 advertised stud fee (minimum of \$500) and a penalty fee of \$500 is made no later than June 30th, 2012. The 'gait' of the stallion must be designated at the time of nomination. All stallion fees are segregated by gait and allocated equally to the three-year-old events for the stallion's gait.

A yearling of 2014 cannot be nominated unless its sire was nominated on January 15, 2012, for the 2012 breeding season or unless its sire was a late nomination by June 30th, 2012.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Stallion nominations made by mail must be clearly postmarked no later than the date on which nominations close.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** Only foals of 2013 conceived as a result of matings between January 1 and December 31 of 2012 and sired by registered Canadian stallions duly nominated to the Canadian Breeders Championship will be eligible to be nominated to these events.
3. Every stallion must have been registered with Standardbred Canada or the United States Trotting Association on the date he started the stud season for which he is nominated.
4. The stallion must stand his entire Northern Hemisphere stud season in Canada. A stallion's 'Northern Hemisphere stud season' shall be defined as having started the day he bred his first mare in that calendar year in the Northern Hemisphere and ended on the day he bred his last mare in that calendar year in the Northern Hemisphere.
5. Foals conceived from frozen semen will be eligible to the Canadian Breeders Championship only if the semen was collected and frozen in Canada and is from a stallion that was registered for the Canadian Breeders Championship both at the time of collection and when the mare was inseminated.
6. If a Canadian Breeders Championship registered stallion dies during the breeding season, the breeder may use frozen semen to finish that Northern Hemisphere breeding season only if the stallion has been properly registered for that season.
7. The Canadian Breeders Championship administration will not recognize foals as twins if produced through embryo/ovum transfer. If such foals were produced through embryo/ovum transfer, only the donor mare's first born foal, registered with either Standardbred Canada or the USTA, will be eligible for nomination.
8. 'Bred' shall be defined as the mating of Standardbred stallions to Standardbred mares, either naturally or artificially, and regardless of whether or not a foal results from such mating.
