The Ontario Racing Commission, a self-financing regulatory agency responsible for the regulation of the horse racing industry in Ontario, has an immediate opening for the position of:

INVESTIGATOR LEVEL I

As an ORC Investigator, attached to the Investigations Unit, you will assist the Commission in achieving its mandate by participating in searches at racetracks, summons service, conducting human alcohol and drug testing, confirming the trainer of record, and completing investigations into violations of the Rules of Racing. You will also prepare detailed written reports on duties conducted and attend at Commission and Judges' and Stewards' hearings to present evidence on cases brought before them.

This position requires extensive travel throughout Ontario and time away from home.

Qualifications: Good knowledge of: the Racing Commission Act, Standardbred, Thoroughbred and Quarter Horse racing, its rules and the ability to interpret and apply them; racetrack operations; and racetrack security. Working knowledge of other legislation including: the Federal Criminal Code, drug statutes; pari-mutuel wagering regulations; and rules of evidence. Prior practical investigative experience, horse racing industry knowledge and bilingual word skills are assets. The salary range is \$53,501 – \$66,876.
