



Part-time Racing Official

The Ontario Racing Commission, a self-financing regulatory agency responsible for the regulation of the horse racing industry in Ontario, has a dynamic cross-training opportunity for the part-time positions of:

Racing Officials (Judge/Steward)

This position is open to candidates with an education in law, enforcement, business or related disciplines, who may have a general appreciation or knowledge of horse racing. These disciplines should enhance and develop the broad knowledge, skills and abilities of the current ORC team officiating Standardbred, Thoroughbred and Quarterhorse racing. In the capacity of Judge/Steward, the incumbent will become part of a panel of three to govern, direct, control and regulate racing at racetracks in Ontario, participate in investigations and Judges'/ Stewards' hearings as required.

Qualifications: Preference will be given to applicants who have racing knowledge as well as an education in business administration or other relevant disciplines that would continue to expand the professional skill base of the ORC. Completion of the Standardbred Canada accreditation examination for Judges with a passing mark of 70% or better would be an asset and/or will be required.

Other Skills: Computer skills, demonstrated inter-personal skills and leadership capabilities; ability to work effectively under pressure with initiative, integrity and sound judgment; conflict resolution; excellent written and verbal communication skills and a valid Ontario Driver's License.

Irregular hours of work include weekends, evenings and holidays at racetracks across the province.
