

Rules & Regs for 2012 Breeders Crown Fantasy Draft

- 1. The draft will start promptly at **6:30 p.m** on Thursday, October 18 in the boardroom at Standardbred Canada's head office at 2150 Meadowvale Blvd. in Mississauga, Ontario. Draft procedures and rules will be reviewed at 6:15 p.m. All players must be registered by **6:00 p.m.**
- 2. Each player will draft a stable of six horses, one trainer and one driver competing in the 2012 Breeders Crown races at Woodbine Racetrack on October 19, October 20, and October 27, 2012.
- Players will receive points based on the official finishing position of their horses, trainer and driver in Breeders Crown elimination races and finals.
- 4. Players may select a horse or trainer or driver from any of the elimination races, or finals for events where elimination races are not required, provided they are available for drafting.
- 5. Horses, trainers and drivers may be drafted twice but by different players.
- 6. The order of the start of the draft will be done by random draw; the order of the draft will reverse for every round.
- 7. Following the completion of the draft, it is up to the players to verify their stable and confirm with contest officials.
- 8. There will be no trading of horses or people allowed.

- 9. Standardbred Canada will provide an updated leader board on October 22, 2012, and the final official results on October 29, 2012 on the Standardbred Canada website.
- 10. **Scoring** Players will receive the following points based on the finish position for their horses:

Finish	Elim	Final	Final with no elims/ Horses with byes
1	10	20	30
2	5	10	15
3	2	5	7
Scratch	1	2	3

Dead Heat – Points will be added for the dead heat position and next position (if two horses) or next two positions (if three horses) and divided by the number of horses.

11. **Scoring** - Players will receive the following points based on the official finishing positions for their trainers & drivers:

Finish	Elim	Final	Final with no elims
1	3	6	6
2	2	4	4
3	1	2	2

Dead Heat – Points will be added for the dead heat position and next position (if two horses) or next two positions (if three horses) and divided by the number of horses.

12. The player with the highest score for their stable, following the completion of the 2012 Breeders Crown Championships will receive a spot in the World Harness Handicapping Championship, and 75% of the prize pool* which includes \$500 to be used towards travel expenses. The runner up will receive 25% of the prize pool*.

*The prize pool will be (# entrants x \$50)

- 13. In the event of a tie, the player with the most number of winning horses selected will win. If there is still a tie, there will be a random draw to determine the winner.
- 14. In the event of any discrepancies the contest officials will make the final decision and reserve the right to make any changes deemed in the best interest of the contest.

- 15. Player eligibility Players must be 19 years of age and over. Directors and employees of Standardbred Canada, the Hambletonian Society and officers and employees of Woodbine Entertainment Group and their immediate family members, and its subsidiaries are not eligible to participate in the Championship. Entrants who are Canadian residents must have valid Canadian passports. All entrants must be available to travel and arrive for the WHHC at The Meadowlands no later than 3 p.m. (EST) on Friday, April 12, 2013 to participate in the 2013 WHHC at The New Meadowlands Racetrack in New Jersey.*
- 16. **Grand Prize** The Grand Prize consists of entry into the 2013 World Harness Handicapping Championship on Saturday, April 13 at The New Meadowlands Racetrack, plus 75% of the contest prize pool, which includes \$500 to be used towards travel expenses. This prize is not transferable.
- 17. In the event that the winner can not attend the WHHC, the second place player will be offered the opportunity. The winner will then receive 75% of the contest prize pool, less the \$500 to be used towards travel expenses for the WHHC representative.
- 18. Liability Standardbred Canada's liability is limited to the total amount of the prize pool plus the \$1,000 entry fee for the WHHC. (maximum \$2,500)

- Entries will be taken on first come, first serve basis, with a valid credit card. There will be no refunds.
- ✓ Standardbred Canada has the right to cancel the event if less than 20 players have registered by 5 p.m. on October 17. If the event is canceled, all monies will be refunded.
