## **Earnings & Purses**

- 1,629,500 Record purse (won by Mantacular in 2004)
- 1,431,692 Highest earnings of a Cup starter (Die Laughing who was 3rd in 1991)
- 814,750 Largest purse cheque (paid to M and L of Delaware Inc., owners of Mantacular in 2004)
- 357,900 Lowest purse (1984)
- 20,350 Lowest earnings of a Cup starter (Stagecraft Hanover was 9th in 1996)
- 17,895 Smallest purse cheque (paid to the Estate of John Froehlich, owner of Farmsteads Fame who was 5th in the 1984 Cup final. However, Farmsteads Fame earned an additional \$9,543 for finishing 3rd in his elimination which in 1984 was contested on the same night as the final.)
- 9,750 Purse of the inaugural Queen City Pace won by Timely Knight and Roger White in 1964. The Queen City Pace was discontinued after Ralph Hanover's win in 1983 and was replaced by the North America Cup in 1984.
- 7,313.73 Dollars per second won by Mantacular when he was paid \$814,750 for 1 minute, 51 and 2/5ths seconds of work in winning the richest Cup in 2004
- 6,931.60 Dollars per second won by Well Said when he was paid \$750,000 for 1 minute, 48 and 1/5th seconds of work in winning the fastest Cup in 2009.
- 142.04 Dollars per foot traveled that will be paid to the 2010 winner (\$750,000 for one mile or 5280 feet)
- 130 Starters have earned a purse cheque
- 7 Millionaires have started in the Cup (from 241 total starters). Die Laughing (\$1,431,692) was 3rd in 1991; Presidential Ball (\$1,234,104) won in 1993; Mach Three (\$1,221,208) was 2nd in 2002; Jeremes Jet (\$1,205,542) was 6th in 2006; Bettors Delight (\$1,093,411) won in 2001; Allamerican Native (\$1,073,660) was 2nd in a dead-heat in 2003; and Western Hanover (\$1,030,057) was 2nd in 1992.
- 0 Dollars earned in the Cup by a number of prominent horses, including Camtastic who was 8th by 2 ¾ lengths in 1988; Beach Towel broke and was 9th in 1990; Riyadh was 6th at 14-1 in 1993; Red Bow Tie was 7th at 6-1 in 1997; Royalflush Hanover was 6th in 1999; Real Desire faded to 9th in 2001, etc. Each of these horses went on to win between \$2 million and \$3 million before retiring.

## Nominations, Fees, etc.

- 13,500 Dollars each starter in 2010 will have paid in nomination, sustaining and starting fees. (\$500 on Feb 16; \$1500 on March 15; \$1500 on April 15; \$2000 on May 15; and starting fee of \$8000).
- 133 Record number of horses nominated to the 2009 Cup 41 more than one year earlier when 92 horses were nominated. The previous record of 112 nominations was set in 2005.
- 89 Horses paid the February 16th nomination fee for the 2010 Cup. The fee was due on the 16th as February 15th fell on a holiday (President's Day in the US and Family Day in Ontario).
- 78 Horses paid the March 15th sustaining fee for the 2010 Cup.
- 69 Horses paid the April 15th sustaining fee for the 2010 Cup.
- 63 Horses paid the May 15th sustaining fee for the 2010 Cup.

- 5 Cups in which the longest shot on the board finished last: Mr Rodeo Drive was 45-1 in 1986, Negotiable was 106-1 in 1989, Thunder Bay was 47-1 in 2000, Articulator was 81-1 in 2003, and Millionaire Cam was 88-1 in 2009.
- 4 Cups in which the top two favourites finished first and second.
- 2.70 Lowest win price (Jate Lobell in 1987 and Presidential Ball in 1993)

- 7 Cup winners were voted Pacer of the Year in the United States. That includes just 3 of the first 21 Cup winners (Precious Bunny in 1991, Cams Card Shark in 1994 and Gallo Blue Chip in 2000) and 4 of the last 5 Cup winners (Rocknroll Hanover in 2005, Total Truth in 2006, Tell All in 2007, Somebeachsomewhere in 2008).

#### **Horse Names**

35 - Starters with a "one word" name. Of those 35, only Sombeachsomewhere and Mantacular managed to win. Seven horses with a "one word" name have finished second (Squirter, Neutrality, Stout, Workplace, Tyberwood, Artesian and Metropolitan) and seven finished third (Pinocchio, Kingsbridge, Megamind, Camotion, Horselaughter, Mcardle, Panspacificflight). In the 26 years that the Cup has been raced, and only Somebeachsomewhere and Mantacular won with a "one word" name, a grand total of 9 Thoroughbreds with a "one word" name have won the Kentucky Derby (Barbaro, Giacomo, Monarchos, Charismatic, Grindstone, Unbridled, Alysheba, Ferdinand and Swale). Ironically, when Mantacular won the Cup in 2004 EACH of the top three finishers had a "one word" name as Metropolitan was second and Panspacificflight was third. Some of the better "one word" horses that failed to win the Cup have been: Guts, Astreos, Camotion, Artesian, McArdle, Riyadh, Stout, Workplace (who had the lead at the top of the stretch but broke and finished second) and Dali. In 2006 the "one word" starters were Doonbeg and Impeccable. Both made breaks. The only "one word" name in the 2007 field was Artriverderci and he drew post 10. In 2008 there were 2 starters with a one word name. Somebeachsomewhere won and Dali was 8th. In 2009 Annieswesterncard finished 9th. Perhaps Bill O'Donnell would have had better luck in the Cup had he not be paired with names like Guts, Laag and Camtastic.

20 - Letters in "Pepsi North America Cup"

16 – Date in June, 2007 that Tell All won the Cup. Earlier on the same day 62-year-old rocker Rod Stewart married his third wife, Penny Lancaster. In 2003 seven of Stewart's ex-girlfriends were featured in "Rods Girls", a British produced "tell all" documentary on the veteran womanizer.

07/02/1984 – Date of the inaugural Cup. The first Cup was raced on a Monday evening and the eliminations and final were on the same card. Program advertising at the time stated that it was being held "one day after Canada's birthday and 2 days before the American national holiday."

06/23/1990 – Date that Apaches Fame won the Cup AND TV Guide selected Arsenio Hall as 'TV Personality of the Year'

06/23/1986 – Date that Quite A Sensation won the Cup AND Tip O'Neill refused to let Ronald Reagan address the House of Representatives, which did create 'quite a sensation'.

06/07/2008 – Date that ABC broadcaster Jim McKay passed away. Later that same day the undefeated thoroughbred Big Brown was eased up in the Belmont Stakes, ending his quest to become the first Triple Crown winner in 30 years. One television commentator mused that there WILL never be another Jim McKay and there MAY never be another Triple Crown winner.

He defeated, among others, 1908 Olympic champion John J. Hayes. In 1984 another John Hayes won the first North America Cup with Legal Notice. Finishing third in the inaugural Cup was Long Fella and driver Tom Harmer.

2 – Date in July of the latest Cup (elims and final for the inaugural Cup were raced on the same program – Monday, July 2, 1984. The last 25 Cups have been held in June.

2 – Major highways (Don Valley Parkway and Gardiner Expressway) were closed on the night that Presidential Ball won the final Cup at Greenwood. Traffic in the downtown area was severely affected. While traffic congestions isn't expected to be a factor when the 2010 Cup is contested at Mohawk, police are warning of numerous road closures in the Toronto area as motorcades travel from Pearson Airport to the downtown core for the G20 Summit which is being held on June 26 and 27.

2 – Geldings have won the Cup (Quite A Sensation and Gallo Blue Chin)

1-2-3 — When Rocknroll Hanover won the Cup in 2005 it was the first Cup win for driver Brian Sears, the second for co-owner Lothlorien Equestrian, and the third for co-owner Jeffrey Snyder and trainer Brett Pelling.
