- 6. Purse distribution:
  - a. 5 or more starters: 50 25 12 8 5%;
  - b. 4 starters: 50 25 15 10%;
  - c. 3 starters: 60 30 10%;
  - d. 2 starters: 65 35%;
  - e. 1 starter: 100%.
- 7. Race conditions will be governed by the rules of the Maritime Provinces Harness Racing Commission and Standardbred Canada.
- 8. All races will be at a distance of 1 mile, unless otherwise stated.
- 9. Claiming is allowed during all legs, consolation and final.
- 10. Post positions for all events will be drawn by the Standardbred Canada Electronic Draw.
