## THOROUGHBRED DIRECTIVE NUMBER 4 – 2011 RULES OF THOROUGHBRED RACING 2009

The Ontario Racing Commission at its meeting of Thursday, January 27, 2011 resolved that the Rules of Thoroughbred Racing 2009 be amended by the promulgation of the following Rule, with an effective date subject to the closing of the public process. The public process is complete and the Rule is now effective immediately.

Please note: Changes to the rule are noted in **bold**.

## Chapter 27 COMMISSION VETERINARIANS, OFFICIAL VETERINARIANS AND OTHER VETERINARIANS

**Rule 27.20** A veterinarian who dispenses a drug or medication shall label the container in which the drug or medication is dispensed with the following information:

- i. Name and strength of the drug or medication,
- ii. Date and quantity prescribed,
- iii. Name and address of the dispensing veterinarian,
- iv. Name of the horse for which it is prescribed,
- v. Name of the trainer of the horse,
- vi. Directions for use, and
- vii. Detection limit determined in accordance with Rule 8.10.01.

In the event that the a drug or medication is to be dispensed to multiple horses from a single container, such container shall be marked "BARN USE", and will be exempt from items (ii) and (iv) above and replaced by a written log, to include the following information:

- i. Name of the horse for which it is prescribed, and
- ii. Date and quantity prescribed.
