- 1. Nominations due by July 7th 2014. Those nominating horses to these events are responsible for eligibility.
- 2. Minimum of 14 nominations required to fill this series.
- 3. If only 14 nominations are received, the top eight (8) money earners from the eliminations will race in the final, if more than 14 nominations received the top nine (9) money earners from the eliminations will race in the final.
- 4. If more than eighteen (18) nominations received, the top nine (9) money earners will race in the final, and next the top nine (9) money earners will race in the consolation.
- 5. There must be a minimum of six (6) entries for the consolation. In the event that there are fewer than six (6) entries, Red Shores reserves the right to cancel the consolation.
- 6. In the event of a tie, the entry will be selected by lot.
- 7. Purse distribution:
 - a. 5 or more starters: 50 25 12 8 5%;
 - b. 4 starters: 50 25 15 10%;
 - c. 3 starters: 60 30 10%;
 - d. 2 starters: 65 35%;
 - e. 1 starter: 100%.
- 8. Race conditions will be governed by the rules of the Maritime Provinces Harness Racing Commission and Standardbred Canada.
- 9. All races will be at a distance of 1 mile unless otherwise stated.
- 10. Post positions for all events will be drawn by the Standardbred Canada Electronic Draw.
- 11. Red Shores reserves the right to refuse any nomination, return fees, rearrange programs and in the event that on the day of the scheduled race, the operation of races cannot be held for any reason whatsoever, they reserve the right to reschedule the race to an MPHRC approved future race date or cancel it in which case all monies paid will be refunded.
